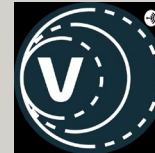
About

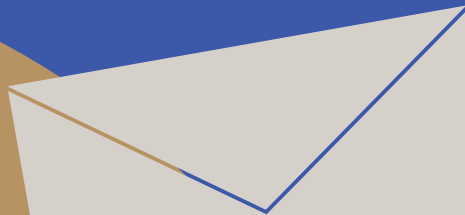

About

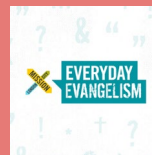
Intercultural Mission explores the practice of intentionally reaching out to people from other cultures and integrating ourselves into a community, entering one another's multifaceted cultures.

The church survey, books and tests are all oriented around the eight Discipling Areas identified by NCD in its global research in over 100,000 settings in 70+ countries.

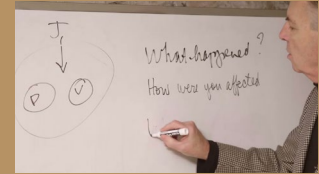
