

Easter Series Summary

A Bassline Guide to Easter

The Bassline Guide to Easter aims to help the young people understand and discuss the key events of Holy Week. This series provides flexibility to focus on the more unfamiliar aspects of Holy Week while gaining an understanding of the overarching message of the Easter story.



Session 1: Palm Sunday to Maundy Thursday

Bible Ref: Zechariah 9:9; Matthew 21:18-22; Matthew 26:14-16; Mark 14:12-26

The Bassline Guide to Easter takes the young people through the events of Holy Week. In session one, we'll start with Jesus' triumphant entry into Jerusalem, watch as he turns the tables in the temple, observe the betrayal of a close friend, and listen as he sings with his disciples. Each moment will lead us through the events of Holy Week, pausing on Thursday before concluding our journey in next week's session.

You will need:

- Holy Week Planner Handout
- Paper for cross activity
- Scissors

Session 2: Good Friday to Easter Sunday

Bible Ref: Mark 15:21-40; Luke 24:1-12

In our second part of the Bassline Guide to Easter, we continue our journey through Holy Week. In this session we will focus on the events of Good Friday through to Easter Sunday. The young people will have the opportunity to reflect on the sacrifice Jesus made for them and celebrate his resurrection.

You will need:

- Paper and pens
- Holy Week Planner Handout (continued from last week)
